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DECLARATION

I declare that the information I have provided on this form is, to the best of my understanding and belief, complete and correct. I understand that providing false or incomplete information may lead to the rejection of my application or cancellation of my enrollment. I give the School permission to obtain any official education records or other details from the educational institution that I am currently attending or have previously attended.

I further declare that I have carefully reviewed and fully understand the Tuition Fee Refund Policy of the School and I agree to abide by the Refund Policy without any reservation.

I further understand that the school is required by law to report any breaches of my study permit or temporary resident visa to the appropriate Canadian authorities.

Tuition Fee Refund Policy

- 1. The application or registration fees and other administrative charges (textbooks, materials, living expenses, etc.) are NON-REFUNDABLE and are NOT included in the tuition fee.
- 2. The tuition must be paid fully before the first class begins. The students can start or continue their studies only after all the tuition and other administrative charges are paid.
- 3. The deadline for paying the tuition is the last Friday before the start of the first enrolled class. The penalty for overdue payments is 2%, compounded per week.
- 4. International students CANNOT terminate the visa application process and CANNOT claim a tuition refund during the process of applying for student authorization, except under the following circumstances:
- 4.1 The student has lost his or her learning and financial capability as a result of a severe injury or death of the student or of the principal sponsor and will be consequently unable to attend school. In this case, the student or the principal sponsor must provide the high school with proof of a notarized certificate issued by a Coroner's Office or a certified letter of health status from a municipal public hospital recognized by the government of the student's home country.
- 4.2 The Canadian Immigration Authority has declined the student's application for a study permit. In this case the student must produce the following documents to process a tuition refund:
- a. The original copy of the student's written request and the completed application form for the tuition refund;
- b. The original copy of the decline letter from the Canadian Embassy or Consulate;
- $\hbox{c. The original copy of the official Acceptance Letter is sued by the high school;}\\$
- d. The original copy of the tuition fee receipt issued by the high school.

When all of the above documents are received and verified, the high school shall refund all the tuition fees to the applicant's designated account. The refund shall be processed no later than two months after the written refund request, completed refund application form, and all other required documents are received.

5. International students who withdraw their enrollment from Maple International College of Secondary Studies and terminate the visa application process after accepting the Offer of Admission from the high school and/or claim for a tuition refund when applying for student authorization will either have his/her tuition fee deposit confiscated by the high school, or will be levied a penalty in the amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the high school's one-year full-time program tuition fee.



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6. International students who have been granted student authorization to study in Canada by the Canadian Immigration Authority with the high school's Acceptance Letter and/or any other documentation AND assistance from the College will NOT be entitled to a refund of any fee, regardless of whether or not they have arrived in Ontario.

7. A current student whose application for a renewal or an extension of a study permit and/or temporary resident/visitor visa has been declined for any personal reasons, such as unsatisfactory academic performance, poor attendance, serious violation of the high school's rules and regulations, and/or whose study permit is revoked by the Canadian Immigration Authority, because of a violation or breach of the terms and conditions of the student's authorization or temporary resident/visitor visa will not be entitled to a refund of any fees.

8. Any student who has been given any form of scholarship, bursary, award, preferential financial package, tuition fee discount, and/or any other form of special financial incentive to study at the high school is not entitled to a tuition refund.
